One Cainta College added another feather on its cap during the CHED Gawad Parangal 2021 at the Batangas State University, Lipa City, Batangas on June 25, 2021.

Dr. Victoria C. Naval, OIC-College Administrator and Ms. Privada B. Gonzales, Member of the OCC Board of Trustees, received the awards on behalf of the college.

Gawad Parangal is an annual awarding ceremonies, recognizing the efforts of the local universities and colleges in meeting institutional standards set by the Commission on Higher Education. With this accolade, One Cainta

College has received not only government recognition but also a certificate of eligibility to receive Unified Student Financial Assistance System for Tertiary (UniFAST) Education subsidy funds from CHED in line with the Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act (R.A. 10931).

CHED ROAT VIRTUAL MONITORING VISIT FOR OCC 2021



One Cainta College has successfully received its Certificate of Program Compliance for 3rd and 4th year programs of all its Bachelor Degree Courses after a series of virtual monitoring visits and careful evaluation of the Regional Quality Assessment Teams (RQAT) delegated by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED).

The RQAT monitoring visits determine and assure the full compliance of every OCC department and office with the Institutional Quality and Standards on Programs,

Instructions, and Research & Extensions mandated by CHED. But due to the ongoing pandemic, the visits and presentations were done via online meetings.

The virtual visits were organized by the OCC College Administrator, Dr. Victoria C. Naval, Dean Teresita G. Carey, and the OCC department heads. All RQAT visits were hosted by Dr. Mariam Fatima Sta. Ana. Three groups of CHED RQAT Panel conducted the evaluation – one for each degree program.

OCC WEBINAR ON MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS




She discussed the importance of mental health and well-being, and some tips in overcoming stress and avoiding the triggers of mental health issues.




The resource speaker was Prof. Flora A. Arellano, President of E-Net Philippines, and one of the prime faculty members of One Cainta College.

GENERAL FACULTY MEETINGS


